

HORSE INSTRUCTIONS:

Happy Trails Horse Ranch

Horses by Ladyartista Labrada

Congratulations on your purchase of one of the fine steeds from the stables of Happy Trails Ranch. These spirited horses were bred from the finest bloodlines and will provide many hours of exploring SL on horseback.

***1. Important: after your purchase, make a copy of your horse. To do this, rez your horse on the ground, then right click and choose "Take a copy" in the pie menu. This will put a copy of your horse in inventory. This will insure that you have a backup should something terrible and SL causes you to lose your horse.

***2. Before riding (wearing from inventory) your horse, turn off your AO's, walking & running animation overrides.

If you cannot ride your horse, and it appears that you are still walking rather than sitting on the horse, then check your shoes for an AO attachment. Be sure to detach that. Your horse will be attached to your pelvis, so if you are wearing a flexi skirt, your skirt will disappear. Even with a sidesaddle, flexi skirts will go away. Two attachments cannot exist in the same spot.

***3. After you've made a copy of your horse you can *Wear* the horse from inventory, or from the ground.

To wear from inventory, right click in inventory on the horse's name, and choose 'wear', (just like you do with clothing or hair). If the horse is on the ground, right click on it, choose 'more', and then choose 'wear'.

Important tips....

To make your horse run,

Choose "always run" from the world menu, or Ctrl R.. choose the same again to return to a walk. The legs move at the same speed to prevent sim lag or crashing, but you will move faster, hear the sound of galloping hooves, and kick up dust on run.

To Jump,

Tap Page up

Modifications:

At this time, the horses are no modify. This is to prevent the animations from 'breaking' in your horse. These horses are made more to scale, in proportion to the average avatar's size.
