# Simple Chair Sit Scene #1

2 part scene for adult female avatar shape - Bento & System hands



#### **GENERAL INFO**

Animation scene or sequence is multi part animation created to be sequenced together with a sequence-capable tool (for example with AVSitter or MLP), giving you an experience of seamless, natural scene, beyond SL length limitations.

Sequence ready files are not intended to be used separately, but only within a scene in a given order and setup.

Positions of animations will always be the same within sequence. For easier adjustment, static pose for position adjustment is included in the pack (positions must be adjusted according to the given object!)

As parts of the scenes are connected with the script, it is very possible to see transitions between animations on first couple of plays. Once in the cash, they will work normally. Preview demo inworld by clicking on "See item in Second Life" direct link at the bottom of the MP listing page.

[RNP] Simple Chair Sit Scene #1 is a single sit for adult female avatar shape, made out of 2 animations. It may be used on on any suitable seat, but it is made with standard chair dimensions in mind.

It includes Bento hand animations but can play on system hands as well, and in that case hands will be in "Relaxed" position.

















Animations are uploaded with official Second Life Viewer.

Scene has been tested with AvSitter 2 and MLPV2 in Singularity Alpha, Firestorm and SL Viewer with cleared and uncleared cache and they are working flawlessly.

Bento hand animations has been tested on Maitreya and SLINK Bento hands and they are working flawlessly.

Tested with system avatar as well.

[RNP] Simple Chair Sit Scene #1 is 89 seconds long animation and will walk you trough multiply body poses. Each body pose has its own micro action with rich movements of the all parts of the body needed to paint specific moment.

In the pack are included demos with setups for both AVsitter sequence modes, as well as MLPV2 demo. Please use them as reference/helpers for setting up the sequences in your creations.

POSE PosSetup included in demo stands as static pose (SCF1Wait in demo content) is meant to be used for animation position setup according to the object you want to use for you creation and should be removed after avatar position setup is done.

If you are AvSitter 2 user, [RNP] high recommendation for this particular scene is to be used with "built-in" method as there is no need for scene controller [RNP] Simple Chair Sit Scene #1 - Female – hands details
