

## What is the M Stream?

- In this package you will have everything you need to start broadcasting your audio live to the Internet (being it Second Life or Real Life) right away without any hassle.
- We offer you a full basic set of features including a high bitrate stream, because we
  believe your audience deserves the best sound quality possible, a big amount of
  listener slots (512), might sound a bit overkill but you never know how big your
  audience is going to be, so we offer you right of the bat a good number so you don't
  need to upgrade your stream package for a while.




Figure 2 – Status Page with embedded player

- We also offer you a custom URL option, completely free of charge so you can have your DJ name, Club name, whatever you want on the link itself (figure 1), so you can share it with your friends, that can listen to it anywhere and on any Internet enabled device, thanks to our embedded basic player on the status page (figure 2).
- You'll also have access to the administration settings of your stream where you can check your passwords, check your live listeners, ban and kick listeners, among other options.

Figure 1 – Custom URL example

Password:

\* This may not be correct and is a best guess from the current connection.

The \*Legacy Password\* is for use with legacy sources (which are sources that are not able to directly specify the desired stream number).

This allows for use of any Shoutcast compatible source on any of the currently configured streams.

If connecting a legacy source to stream #1, the \*Password\* value can be used.

The example JSON-P response uses callback-func which can be changed to a custom value as required for usage.
